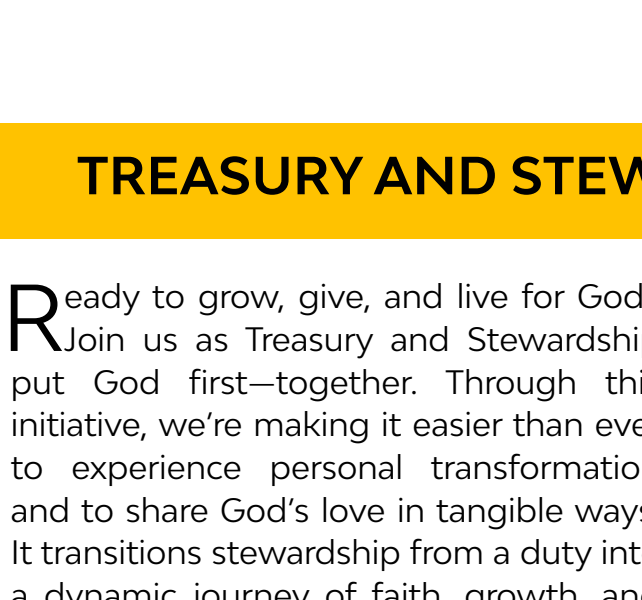

TREASURER'S REPORT— 2025 SPRING MEETINGS

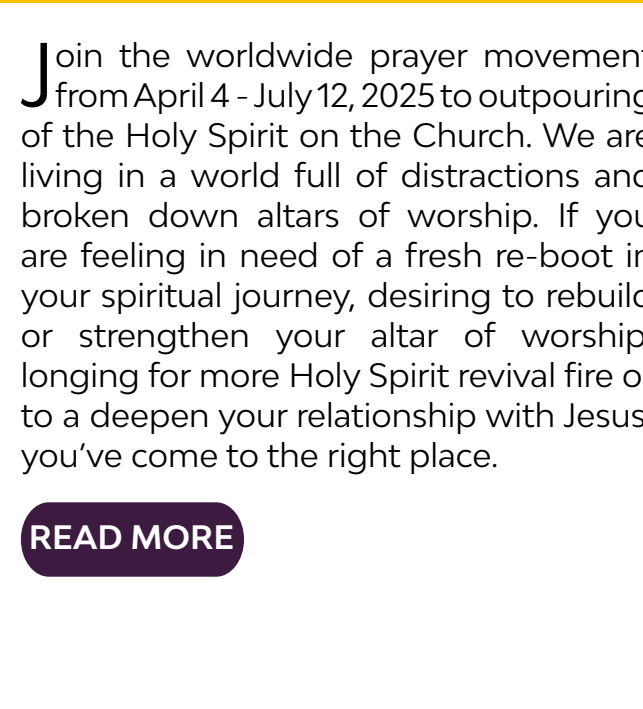

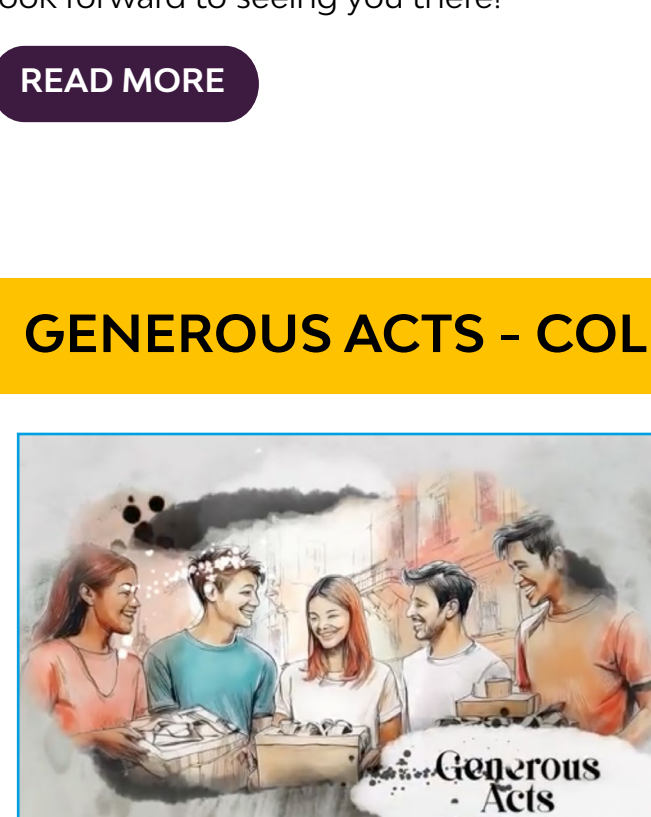

BACK TO THE ALTAR —100 DAYS OF PRAYER

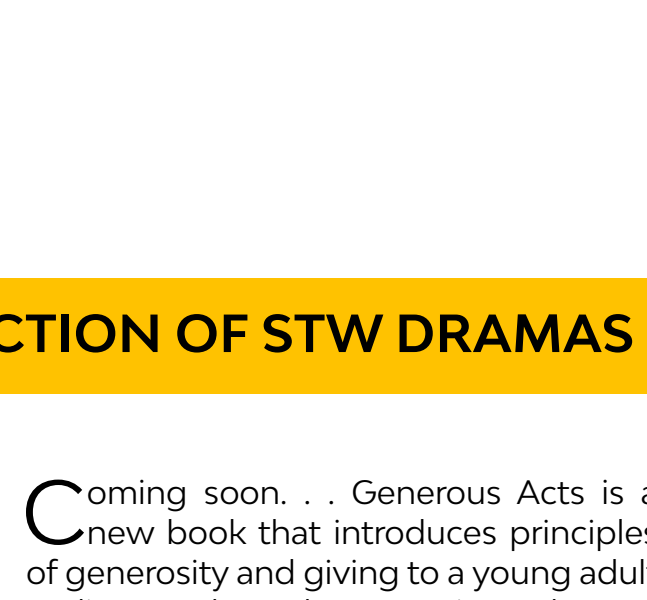

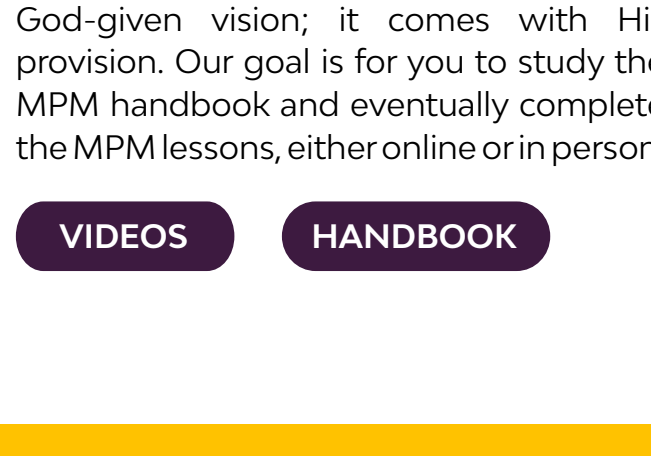

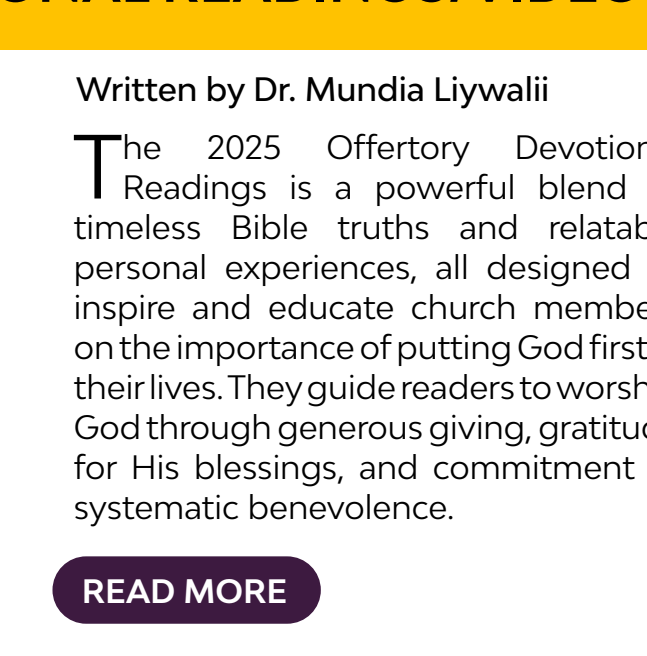
Building Up Your Big Projects

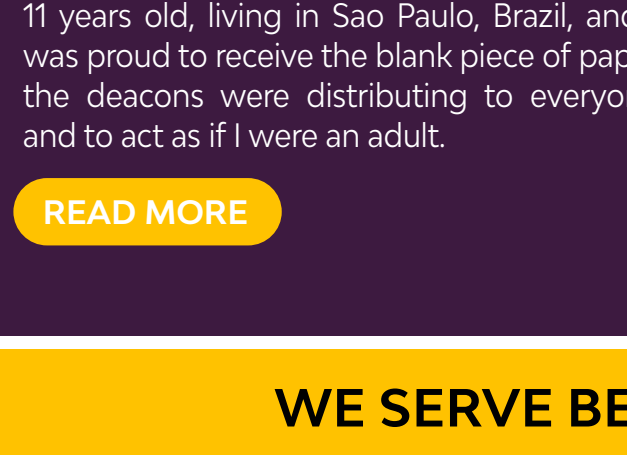


PODCAST: ONLY NEEDS, OR ALSO DESIRES?

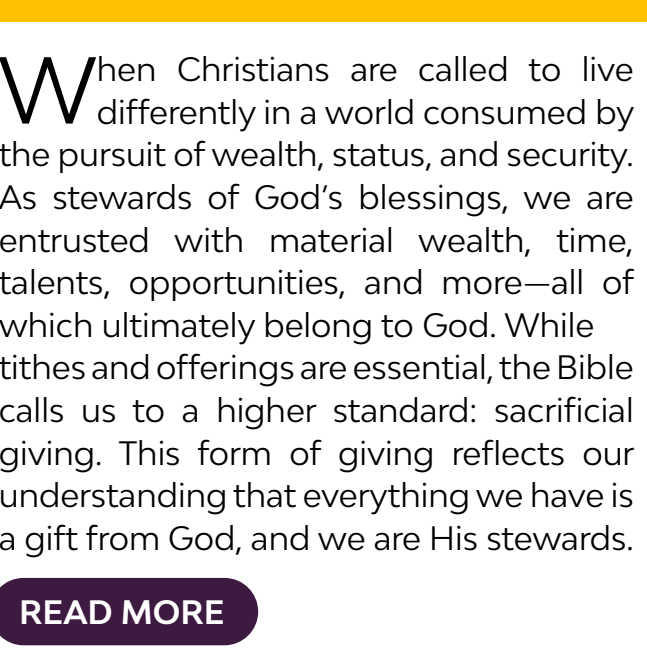

LEARNING TO LIVE BY FAITH

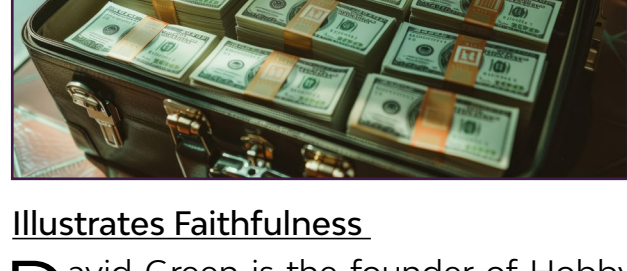

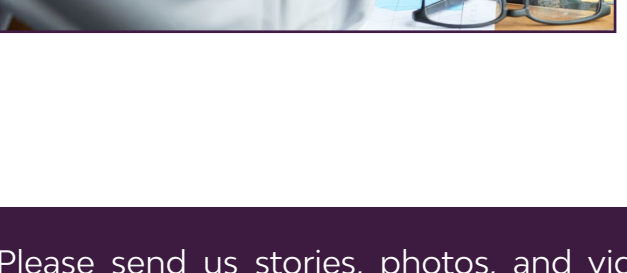

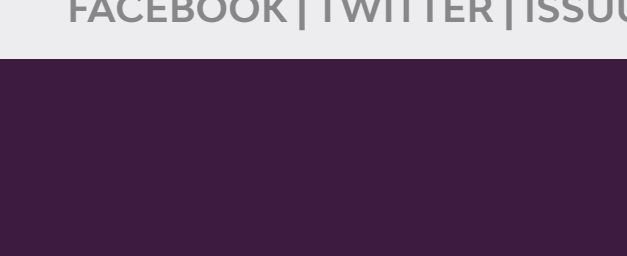
